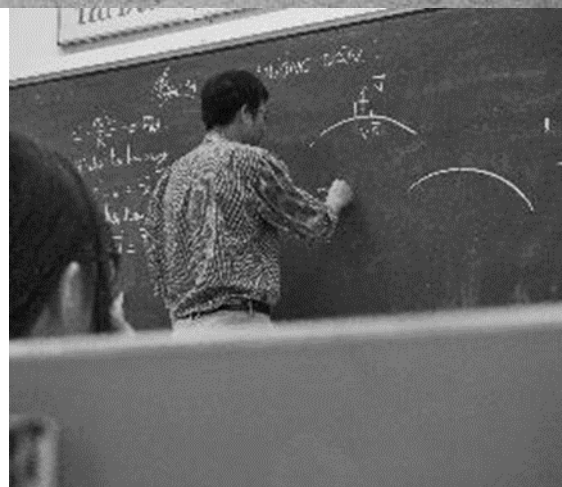
#### Purpose
